



## 2026 WSOP Vlogger Credential Guidelines

### Credential Policy

- WSOP grants Vlogger credentials at its sole discretion
- Credentials are non-transferable, must be visibly worn at all times, and may be revoked for misuse.
- Unauthorized use may result in removal from property or trespassing action. All creators must display valid WSOP credentials while filming on-site.

### Eligibility Requirements

- Demonstrated poker content creation experience
- Active platforms with consistent audience engagement
- Content aligned with WSOP standards and reputation

Applicants without an established content platform or clear editorial purpose may not be eligible.

### Professional Conduct Guidelines

Accredited Vloggers must:

- Maintain professional and respectful conduct at all times
- Ensure all content is in good taste and does not harm the reputation of WSOP, Horseshoe and Paris, players, staff, sponsors, or stakeholders
- Respect player requests not to be filmed and avoid recording private conversations or sensitive information
- Avoid harassment, intimidation, or disruptive behavior while creating content
- Comply immediately with any request from WSOP staff to stop filming or relocate
- Edited footage may not misrepresent players, staff, tournament action, or WSOP operations. Content that is deceptive, misleading, or intentionally taken out of context may result in credential revocation.

Failure to comply may result in credential revocation and removal from the property.

### **Filming Equipment Rules**

- Only approved handheld or traditional camera equipment may be used.
- Smart glasses, Meta glasses, and all wearable recording devices are strictly prohibited
- Camera setups must remain minimal and may not obstruct players, dealers, staff, walkways, or tournament operations
- Additional device restrictions may apply during streamed events or late tournament stages
- WSOP reserves the right to prohibit all recording devices at final tables, streamed tables, or final three tables at any time.

### **Content Recording Rules**

- Only delayed, edited content is permitted; live streaming from tournament areas is strictly prohibited
- Vloggers may not engage with or distract players during active play
- Filming in casino, hotel, restaurant, or other non-tournament areas requires prior written WSOP approval
- WSOP livestreamed feature tables may not be filmed without prior written authorization.

### **WSOP Livestream Footage Usage Policy**

- Use of WSOP broadcast footage, livestream content, or derivative clips (“Footage”) requires prior written approval from WSOP.
- Footage may not be published or distributed until at least six (6) hours after the original broadcast.
- No single clip may exceed ninety (90) seconds, and clips may not be combined to recreate full hands, segments, or broadcasts.
- All footage must be used in a transformative manner, including commentary, analysis, reporting, or editorial context.
- Graphics, branding, and visual elements used within the original WSOP broadcast may not be altered, obscured, cropped, or manipulated.
- All approved footage must include clear WSOP attribution, including visible credit and, where applicable, a link to the official WSOP broadcast or channel.
- Re-streaming WSOP broadcasts, livestreams, or VOD content is strictly prohibited.
- WSOP reserves the right to monitor usage, request removal of content, and take enforcement action against unauthorized or non-compliant usage.

### **Branding & Sponsorship Guidelines**

- Vlogger credentials may not be used primarily for commercial promotion, advertising, or unauthorized sponsorship activity

- WSOP and Caesars Entertainment reserve the right to revoke credentials and deny future event access for any violation of this policy.

### **Violations & Enforcement**

- Violations of these rules or failure to follow staff instructions may result in immediate removal, credential revocation, and loss of future WSOP access
- Vlogger credentials are a revocable privilege and do not grant legal or commercial rights
- WSOP and Caesars Entertainment reserve the right to revoke credentials at any time, at their sole discretion

Acceptance of credentials constitutes full agreement with these requirements.
